## WHAT IS OKAYAMA GAKUGEIKAN?

### Okayama Gakugeikan Language School

Okayama Gakugeikan Japanese Language School opened in April 2012 for students (18 years old or older) who have graduated from high school in other countries. The school is located alongside a Japanese junior high school and high school, allowing students to share the library, cafeteria, the school nurse's office, and other facilities with Japanese students, providing an optimal environment for language learning where students always have the opportunity to interact with Japanese students.

Our faculty, who have extensive international experience and teaching experience, provide not only classes to improve the four skills of Japanese, but also preparatory classes for the Japanese Language Proficiency Test, university entrance examinations and essay writing, and job interviews. We provide personal support for students studying in Japan, both academically and in their daily lives, and help students to enter universities and find employment in Japan. At Okayama Gakugeikan Language School, students can enjoy a fulfilling study abroad experience where "you can become the person you want to be".

### Okayama Gakugeikan High School

Okayama Gakugeikan High School is a private, co-educational, licensed Japanese high school for students ages 15 to 18. The school was established in 1960 and currently has more than 1,000 students enrolled. The faculty and staff believe that each student has unlimited potential and do all they can to support all students in achieving their dreams. In addition to academic studies, students are also involved in research on various issues such as the environment, welfare, and education. Club activities in various genres are also popular. We are proud of our high university acceptance rate due to our strong commitment to both literary and martial arts.

### Okayama Gakugeikan Seishu Junior and Senior High School

Okayama Gakugeikan Seishu Junior and Senior High School is an educational institution for students between the ages of 12 and 18. It was established in 2010 and offers an integrated six-year education. The school's curriculum is designed for high academic achievement and personal development of the students.

## WHAT IS OKAYAMA GAKUGEIKAN INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION CENTER?

Gakugeikan have two distinct educational goals:

1. To foster students with pride in their heritage, based on a deep understanding of their tradition and culture, including its underlying philosophies and moral code.
2. To foster students with high-level English and Japanese language skills as well as the ability to succeed in the global arena, establishing meaningful international relationships using their deep understanding of other cultures.

In accordance with these goals, the International Educational Center, as the hub for international exchange projects, has received many students from sister and affiliated schools in over ten countries all over the world for more than 20 years. At this center, our experienced Japanese and international faculty members provide close support to all international students.

Sometimes it can be stressful to study abroad, but we believe we can provide safe and comfortable experiences for not only exchange students but also their parents. In an international flavor we foster human resources with understanding Japanese traditional culture and national identity and that can give students an insight about what Japan really is upon returning to their mother countries.

It also enjoys fewer natural disasters such as earthquakes, typhoons, and heavy snow.


