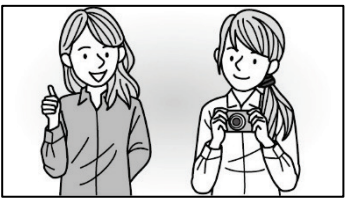
BethからのEメールの一部

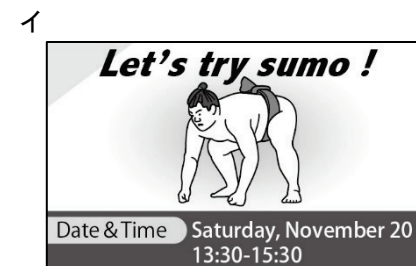

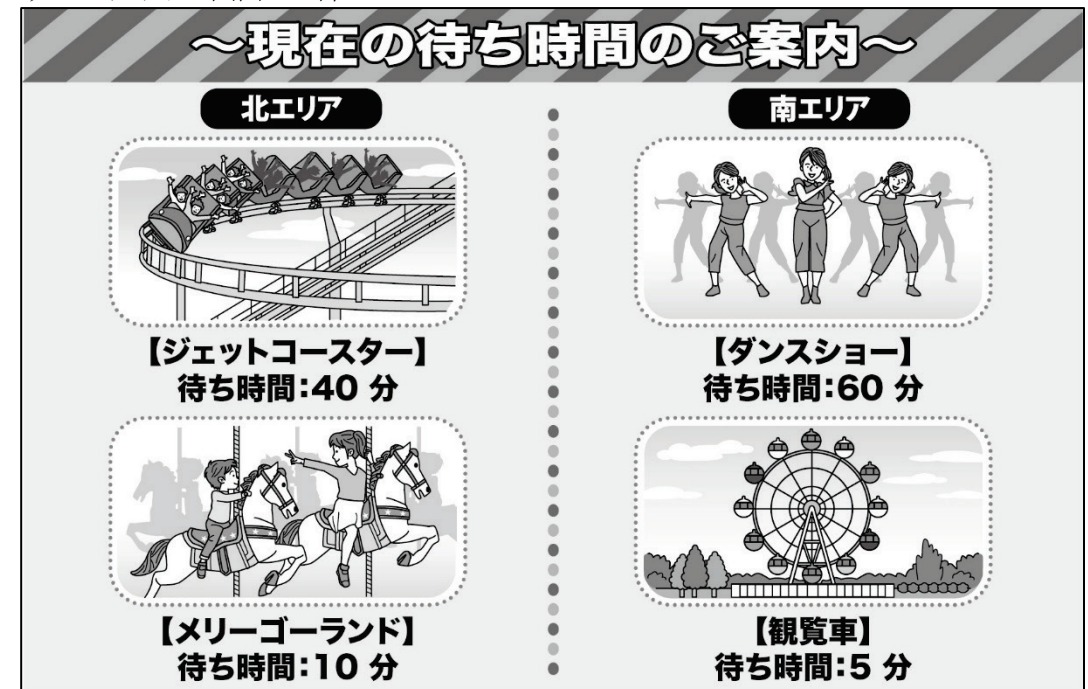

Mr. Baker : Hello, everyone. Our school will have volunteer activities next month. You will work at a park, a library, or a nursing home. Today, please talk in your groups and think about the activity you want to do there.

Hina : Our group is going to work at a nursing home. I want to make the older people smile, and that will make us happy too. What can we do for them ?

Mr. Baker : Last year, some students sang songs, and some cleaned the rooms. The older people were happy about that.

Rie : I also want to sing songs. We will sing some songs in front of them and then sing a popular song that the older people know well. They will join us !

Gaku : Sounds fun ! (あ) they like ?

Rie : Well, maybe they like popular songs from famous movies. But actually, I don't have any ideas. Hina, what will you do for them ?

Hina : I think health is very important. So, I want to do physical exercise with them. I heard that easy yoga would be fun and good for them.

Gaku : Oh, that's a good idea. I think doing exercise is as popular as singing songs. It will be a great way to help them stay active and healthy.

Rie : I like Hina's idea too. However, physical exercise may be hard for some of them. Why don't we play card games with them ? Physical activity is important, but mental activities are also very important !

Mr. Baker : I see. (い) Gaku, do you have any plans for the activities ?

Gaku : I think looking at beautiful flowers is good for them. How about planting flowers in the nursing home garden ? I heard (う) to take / older people / many / care / like of gardens. Some of them will help us plant flowers. After the activity, the flowers will make the older people smile even when we're not there. Seeing flowers is nice. But I think that growing plants means more than that.

Mr. Baker : Many people feel relaxed by gardening.

Gaku : There is another good point about my idea. People can look at plants. If the plants grow well, the older people will see that and be encouraged.

Misa が旅行 (travel) で利用できるサービス (service) について調べ、レポートにまとめました。次の英文は、そのレポートです。(1)～(6)に答えなさい。

Do you like traveling? After we started using the internet, travel has changed a lot. For example, in the old days, people often visited places they saw in travel magazines or on TV. However, many people visit places they see in photos on the internet now. When you travel, you will be happy and excited. On the other hand, what is the most bothersome thing for you during travel? You often have to carry heavy luggage, especially when you travel for many days. This is ^(あ)one of the problems you have. If you could go abroad with just a small bag, how would you feel?

For a trip, most people need some clothes. Maybe you also bring a computer, a hair dryer, or even some cosmetics. When you go abroad, you have to carry a lot of things. Today, more than 80% of foreign visitors to Japan are individual tourists. In the old days, it was hard to get information on hotels, transportation, and so on. So, many people chose package tours. But now, we can check and reserve almost everything online, so more people are choosing individual tours.

If tourists join a package tour, the tour company can look after their luggage. However, individual tourists have to carry everything themselves. ^(い) At the same time, that causes some problems on public transportation. If tourists have large bags, it is hard to walk through crowded streets or visit small shops. This makes tourists tired. Large luggage also needs space, so sometimes ^(う) can't get on a bus or a train. There are even accidents caused by people trying to carry big bags. What are some ways to solve these problems?

In some cities, there are services to help tourists enjoy sightseeing without carrying luggage. With this service, tourists can send their big bags from an airport or a train station to their hotels, and they can enjoy sightseeing with just a small bag. Of course, tourists can use these services in different languages.

^(え) There's also an idea to help tourists carry fewer things. For example, when people travel from a warm country to a cold country, they need a lot of winter clothes. People from warm countries may not even have warm clothes. Now they can rent clothes through a new service. With these services, tourists can reserve a set of clothes online before their trip and receive them at their hotels in Japan. They can rent clothes for men, women, or children for a certain period. To return the clothes, they just put everything back in a bag and return it at any hotel in Japan. This is a very easy and convenient way to travel. This service has other good points. Tourists don't need to buy special clothes for their trip and can save time packing. Carrying heavy luggage on planes uses more fuel, so carrying ^(お) helps reduce CO₂. So, it is also good for the environment. At first, I thought tourists had to buy many things for their trip and carry them. However, now I understand they don't have to worry too much about their luggage. I want them to enjoy many places with ^(か).
